

OKLAHOMA GAS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP POLICY



The Oklahoma Gas Association (OGA) offers a \$1,000 scholarship to assist high school seniors with college tuition, books, fees, or other related educational expenses. The scholarship recipient(s) will be selected by the OGA Scholarship Committee and approved by the OGA Board of Directors. The recipient will be notified no later than **July 1** and recognized at the OGA Annual Conference later that year.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a dependent child, grandchild, or ward of an employee or retiree of an OGA member company in good standing.
2. Be a resident of Oklahoma or a bordering state.
3. Be enrolled for the upcoming fall semester at an accredited 2- or 4-year college, university, or technical training center located in Oklahoma or a bordering state.
4. Submit a complete application package, including all required supporting documents (see below).
5. Have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.0.

Application Requirements

A completed application must include:

1. Essay (Two-page maximum)

The essay must address:

- Academic and extracurricular achievements
- Career goals
- Volunteer or community service experience, including:

2. Letters of recommendation

One or more letters of recommendation from a non-relative (e.g., teacher, counselor, coach, minister, or employer) who is familiar with the applicant's character and achievements.

3. Academic transcripts

- High school transcript reflecting a minimum 3.0 GPA
- If applicable, current college transcripts showing completed credit hours

Additional terms and conditions

- Incomplete application packages will not be considered.
- OGA will award a minimum of one (1) scholarship annually, subject to available funding.
- The scholarship check will be issued to the selected recipient by July 1.
- Completed application packages must be received no later than **May 31** of the applicable calendar year.
